### 7. Loo Kian Chiang School Library

The Loo Kian Chiang School Library has been relocated from Level 3 to Level 1 to improve accessibility and encourage reading amongst our students. As part of the school's 40th anniversary celebration, the refreshed library was officially opened by Ms Lee Xiang Yin, our former School Advisory Committee (SAC) Chairperson (23 October 2018 to 22 October 2024). This vibrant space aims to foster a love for reading and creativity. Students are encouraged to make full use of our diverse collection of books.

### Library Information:

- Opening hours: 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (during school days)
- No. of Books allowed: Up to 2 books per student
- Loan period: 2 weeks
- Requirement: School Smart Card (Student card) needed for borrowing

The library offers a supervised, quiet environment for after-school study.
